Dear Parent/Carer


During the current lockdown we are moving to remote learning accessed at home for most of our pupils with a small number of key workers and more vulnerable children accessing face to face lessons at school.

Staff from each year group are co-ordinating remote learning at home and there will be work to complete each day as well as videos with instructions available on YouTube.

- There are named work packs for every pupil in Y1-Y6 who is working at home. Please collect from the school office. If you have a problem and cannot collect please let the office staff know and someone may be able to drop it off at your home.
- If pupils need equipment for example science (particularly in Y5/6) then we will provide this on short term loan. We will let you know when we need resources back.
- Y1-6 pupils will be supported with videos on YouTube. Let the school office know if you have not received the link.
- Work should be returned to school at least weekly. Staff will mark it and provide feedback (maybe by phone or email). Teaching and support staff can be contacted by phone here at school throughout the school day if anyone is 'stuck' or needs help of any kind.
- 'Activities' for Reception children are accessed via school facebook and work packs (available to collect from the school office).

Thank you for your continued help and support. We are trying to make the system as easy for you to use as possible and feedback from pupils and parents has been really positive so far.
