Please remember to return your permission slip and £10 deposit as soon as possible. If you have any queries please speak to Mrs Westgate and she will be happy to help.

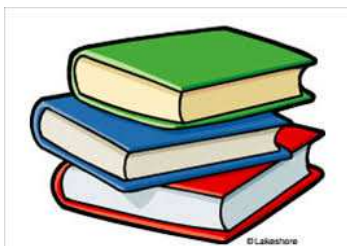


It has been confirmed that Eid will be on Monday 12th September 2016.
